Introduction to Theory of Language Acquisition and Communication: sem. III

The main aim of the course is to introduce basic concepts concerned with language, communication and culture. Students learn about the mechanisms involved in the process of language acquisition and about different approaches to analysing the process with reference to various linguistic and psychological theories. Students recognise the difference between first language acquisition and second language acquisition. They also distinguish between second language acquisition and learning. Moreover, they learn to recognise pragmatic categories that determine successful communication.

In order to complete the course each student is obliged to attend the lectures regularly and prepare his/her own short presentation on an assigned topic. At the end of the semester students take the exam. The final grade is 40% semesterwork and 60% examresult.
